This year's discussions will primarily align with **TOWARDS COP17**, a global initiative building momentum for the United Nations Biodiversity Conference (COP17), which Armenia will host in 2026. In addition to biodiversity priorities, the event will also address broader sustainability challenges, aligning with key international environmental conventions such as the UNFCCC (climate change) and UNCCD (desertification).

Core Elements of the Summit

CONFERENCE – Global COP Youth Dialogue

Structure: The conference features plenary sessions, panel discussions, and workshops led by high-profile UN representatives, climate experts, and environmental activists. Participants will explore pressing global challenges and solutions through dynamic and interactive sessions.

EXPO – Global Innovation Showcase

Objective: Provide a platform for young innovators from all COP Parties to showcase groundbreaking solutions to a global audience.

Structure: A dedicated expo area where each participating Party presents its innovations, engaging with experts, policymakers, and potential sponsors.

Outcome: Amplifies awareness of youth-led solutions, fosters collaboration, and connects innovators with funding and support networks.

COMPETITION – Global Youth Innovation Challenge

Objective: Inspire youth to develop and present innovative solutions that align with COP objectives.

Participants: Each Party nominates a team of 2–3 members who undergo an intensive educational program before pitching their most promising solutions to an international jury.

Prizes: Winning teams receive funding, mentorship, and resources to advance their projects, with recognition at COP, reinforcing the role of youth in shaping actions.

AWARD CEREMONY – Celebrating Champions

Objective: Recognize and honor exceptional youth-led contributions. This prestigious ceremony celebrates young leaders, ensuring their efforts in global solutions are acknowledged and showcased on an international stage.
